

FUNDRAISING TEAM

Primary Responsibility: Serve All Things New by ensuring appropriate and adequate fundraising is taking place.

The fundraising team will be responsible for working with the Executive Director and Board of Directors to develop and implement a fundraising plan. The team should be made up of at least 6 volunteers including at least 1 board member. The following is a list of tasks for which the committee will be responsible:

- Review all fundraising activity in the previous year and make recommendations for each new year.
- Work with the Finance Committee to determine the annual budget and fundraising goal.
- Maintain a fundraising calendar.
- Work with volunteers, board, and staff to focus on these areas of fundraising:
 - Child Sponsorship
 - Corporate Partners
 - Large-Scale Fundraisers (ie. the annual fundraiser in Jacksonville and LaGrange and the Jaguars fundraiser)
 - Small-Scale Fundraisers (ie. Local Spirit Nights, Jewelry Parties, etc.)
 - Church Partnerships (along with the spiritual committee)
 - Grant Writing
 - Speaking Engagements (ie. churches, conferences, service clubs, etc.)
- Form temporary committees when needed to complete large scale tasks.
- Ensure website and other modes of giving are easy and efficient.
- Meet at least 4 times per year but as often as needed.
- Report to the full board.
