

## HAITI TEAM

**Primary Responsibility:** To keep the board updated on Haitian news and to lead the push on job creation in Haiti.

The Haiti Team will be responsible for working with the Executive Director and Board to help push forward the job creation agenda along with keeping the entire organization updated with events in Haiti. The Haiti Team should be made up of at least 4 volunteers 1 of which is a board member. Each member should have an expertise or passion for either Haiti or for job creation to alleviate poverty. The Haiti Team should meet at least quarterly, but more often when needed. The following is a list of tasks for which the Haiti Team will be responsible:

- Update the board when events in Haiti occur that could effect All Things New. This includes but is not limited to:
  - Political upheaval in the country in general
  - Natural disasters
  - Decisions in America that could affect how Americans in Haiti are viewed
  - Decisions by the Haitian government that could affect how orphanages and businesses are run
- Work with the board to decide when to communicate events to the organization as a whole (through newsletters, email, phone calls, blogs, social media, etc.). Wisdom should be used here so that we do not scare people but we do keep people informed of how to pray for our operation in Haiti.
- Help All Things New push forward with a job creation initiative. This may eventually be its own committee, but for now we need people who are invested in Haiti to help the Executive Director and Board understand how to get this initiative started.
- Report to the full board.
