

SPIRITUAL TEAM

Primary Responsibility: To ensure that All Things New never forgets its primary purpose...to worship Jesus Christ.

The Spiritual Team will be responsible for working with the board and Executive Director to ensure that the spiritual health of the organization is strong and that this aspect of All Things New is never forgotten. The Spiritual Team will also be responsible for helping push forward the Discipleship Component in Haiti as this has been established as the primary spiritual need in our community of Haiti. The Spiritual Team will be comprised of at least 5 volunteers 1 of which is a board member. Each Team member should be a follower of Christ who is maturing in his/her faith. The Spiritual Team should meet at least quarterly and more often as needed. The following is a list of tasks for which the Spiritual Team will be responsible:

- Ensure that people are in prayer for All Things New and know how to specifically pray for the ministry.
- Figure out creative and new ways to ensure that All Things New never loses its primary mission...to worship Jesus Christ.
- Figure out ways to communicate the spiritual needs of the organization.
- Foster relationships with churches who currently support All Things New and to seek new relationships with churches.

 - By sending teams
